PROPOSED RULES FOR ALL INDIA ESSAY COMPETITION

1. Officers/Staff from all offices can participate in this All India Essay Competition.
2. The individuals can forward their entries through their field CDA/PCDA/IFA/PIFA/CFA (Fvs) concerned to the email id of Training Division i.e. trgdiv-brar.cgda@nic.in.
3. The competition would be bilingual.
4. The entries should not be of more than 1000 words (the articles A, AN, THE are excluded from the word count in English language essays).
5. The participant must give an undertaking that the essay is their own original piece of writing and has not been copied from other sources. Plagiarism will not be tolerated and if detected would make the entry ineligible. Quotations and excerpts must be put within quotes and relevant sources mentioned.
6. Entries received after the closing date and closing time would not be considered for evaluation.
7. The closing time would be 5 pm of the closing date.
8. There would be three separate prizes for essay entries in both languages.
